

## Access

There are two entrances to the Baldwin Preserve. One is on Route 317 about two miles east of Roxbury green, on the right across from the Lilly Preserve and prior to reaching Bacon Road. Better access is from Lower Country Road, on the left about 0.5 miles from the Route 317 intersection.
