

Access: Greenbelt TRAILHEAD at the Good Hill Farm Preserve off Good Hill Road/Route 317, Woodbury, just east of the farm buildings. Parking and kiosk. Red farm loop and blue trail.

The **GREENBELT** Project resulted from a challenge by Rebecca Miller. If Roxbury Land Trust would purchase a 20-acre parcel, she would donate 100 contiguous acres, resulting in a greenbelt from Good Hill Farm Preserve to Painter Hill Road. RLT implemented a mini-campaign in 2014 with resounding support from the Neighborhood.

The 476-acre Good Hill Farm Preserve was part of RLT's *Campaign to Save Our Farms* and was purchased from the Pond Family in 2003/Roxbury portion and in 2004/Woodbury portion. It was purchased with two grants from Connecticut's Open Space and Watershed Acquisition Fund, a grant from the Town of Woodbury's Open Space Fund and many private donations. In 2014 Good Hill Farm was designated by the State Register of Historic Places as one of 200 important state agricultural properties.

Good Hill Farm Preserve is actively farmed. The reclamation of the old orchard is funded by USDA Natural Resource Conservation Service.
